Note: Repertoire Ballet Class is new and is required for all Intermediate and Advanced Ballet Students. This class is intended to elevate technique and artistry. Students will learn and perform variations from famous ballets. It provides a structured way to explore classical ballet repertoire, including adaptations of pieces from ballets like Coppélia, Giselle, The Sleeping Beauty, Paquita, Swan Lake, and The Nutcracker.

*required to take 2 Ballet technique classes, Repertoire class, Inter 2 Jazz technique, Jazz choreo class (GNG), GNG Conditioning class, Lyrical Class (GNG), Contemporary class (GNG) and large ballet choreo group strongly recommended. Ballet Exam mandatory.

GNG Lyrical - Advanced Lyrical Small Group 14+ invite only (Ashes) Wednesday 4:30-5:30 pm
*required to take 2 Ballet technique classes, Ballet choreo Class, Repertoire class, Inter Jazz technique, Jazz choreo class (GNG), GNG Conditioning class, Contemporary class (GNG) and large contemporary choreo group strongly recommended. Ballet and Jazz exams mandatory

GNG Contemporary - Advanced Contemporary Small Group invite only (Numb) Thursday 9:00-10:00 pm

*required to take 2 Ballet technique classes, Ballet choreo class (GNG), Repertoire class, Inter Jazz technique, Jazz choreo class (GNG), GNG Conditioning class, Lyrical Class (GNG), and large contemporary choreo group strongly recommended. Ballet and Jazz exams mandatory.

GNG Tap – Advanced Tap Small Group invite only – Monday 9:00-9:30 pm * required to take Intermediate 2 Tap Technique class, and large group strongly recommended.

* **NEW GNG Musical Theatre - Advanced Musical Theatre Small Group invite only** – Monday 9:30-10:00 pm

*required to take a competitive jazz class, and large group strongly recommended.

*All GNG Dance and Performance Company students should also take the Inter/Advanced Hip Hop class to prepare them for conventions and future dance opportunities such as Harbour Dance Centre, Cruise ships, etc.

*GNG students are strongly advised to take the Acro Skills class Monday 5:00-5:45 pm

Class Requirements for the 2025-26 Competitive Dance Season

Jazz Dance – must take two Ballet classes and a Jazz technique class and the Stretch and Conditioning class (Mandatory for Ages 10+

Tap Dance – must take a Tap technique class.

Ballet Dance – must take two Ballet classes. Intermediate and Advanced ballet dancers must take the 2 technique classes, in addition to the Repertoire class and large group choreo class.

Lyrical/Contemporary Dance – must take two Ballet classes and for Inter/Adv Contemporary, a jazz technique class, and Stretch and Conditioning class is mandatory.

Acro Dance – Acro skills class and Stretch and Conditioning class strongly advised. Jazz class advised. Skills class mandatory for Advanced Acro class.

Musical Theatre Dance – must take a jazz class (could be non-competitive)

Hip Hop Dance – advised to be registered in any additional dance class.

Solos and Duos are required to take all the necessary Ballet and Technique classes as listed above in addition to the choreography classes in the genre of the solo/duo, and the Stretch and Conditioning class. Students who take solos and duets are also expected to be taking their exams and attend all workshops and training opportunities that are available to them.

Requirements to take a Tap and Jazz Exam:

Students who wish to take their Exams must be enrolled in two Ballet classes, take the Tap Technique class (for tap exam) and Jazz Technique class (for jazz exam), along with their Jazz and Tap group classes. **Only those ready for the exam will take the exam.**

Requirements to take a Ballet Exam: Students will be invited to take an exam:

All Ballet exam students are required to take the Ballet classes outlined for their Grade (minimum 2 classes per week). Students will receive an invitation to take the exam if the teacher feels they are ready.
